DAY 01: LEH ARRIVAL-ACCLIMATIZATIONDAY

- Leh Arrival Acclimatization Day.
- Upon arrival at Leh, head to your hotel.
- Check-in and spend a relaxing day, getting proper rest to give your body a chance to acclimatize.
- In the evening you can go for a stroll to the Leh market Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: LEH LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

- Wake Up & have breakfast at the hotel.
- Post breakfast head for the local sightseeing of Leh.
- Places to Visit Hall of Fame, Shanti Stupa,
 Zanskar & Indus Confluence, Magnetic hills

DAY 03: KHARDUNG LA-NUBRA VALLEY-DISKIT

- After breakfast in the morning, head to Nubra Valley via Khardung-La (Highest motorable road at 5359 mt)
- Nubra Valley is popularly known as Idorma or the valley of flowers. It is situated to the north of Ladakh between the Karakoram and Ladakh ranges of the Himalayas.
- Check in to the hotel and visit the Sand Dunes (cold deserts of India), take a camel safari (self-paid)
- Visit the Monastery around. Come back to the hotel by evening, have dinner and sleep overnight.

DAY 04: NUBRA VALLEY TO TURTUK TO NUBRA VALLEY-OVERNIGHT STAY AT DISKIT

- Wake up to a beautiful sunrise.
- Post breakfast depart for Turtuk, a remote village of about 4,000 residents inhabited by ethnic Muslims, a few kilometers from the 'Line Of Control.
- Turtuk is the penultimate village open to foreign tourists before Pakistan.
- Spend some time in the pristine landscapes of Turtuk Village.
- Come back to Diskit by evening Dinner &Sleep Overnight.

DAY 05: NUBRA VALLEY-PANGONG TSO-SHYOK

- After breakfast check out, start your journey to the famous Pangong Tso via the Agam and Shyok villages.
- Pangong Tso which is perhaps one of the most amazing lakes in Asia changes its color 4-5timesa day.
- The Pangong Lake or "lake of the great holow" is considered as the largest lake in Asia. The water is clearer though salty.
- The Crystal-clear salty water shines in many shades of blue depending upon its depth. It literally changes shades with sunlight.
- With a backdrop of mountains of various hues and colors, it is a sight for the Gods. At an elevation of 4300meters, the air is cool even in summers at Ladakh.
- Reach Pangong Lake &check ni to the campsite. Dinner &sleep overnight.

DAY 06: PANGONG TSO-CHANG LA-LEH

- Wake up early morning to witness a mesmerizing sunrise
- After having breakfast, head back to Leh
- Enroute visit Chang-La, the 2nd highest motorable road in the world at5350m
- Reach by evening time and explore the local market/ cafe's in Leh.
- Come back to the hotel by evening
- Dinner and sleep overnight

DAY 07: DEPARTURE

- Wake up &post breakfast bid farewell to the Leh city.
- Head to the Leh airport as per your flight timings.
- Trip ends with beautiful memories.



1. BOOKING AND PAYMENT TERMS

- 1.1 Booking: A booking is considered confirmed only upon payment of the required deposit.

- 1.3 Payment Schedule: The Client shall pay the Company as follows:
- * Deposit: 20% of Total Amount upon booking
- * Balance payment: Remaining 80% 3 Days before tour date

2. CANCELLATION POLICY

- 2.1 The Client may cancel their booking by providing written notice to the Company.
- 2.2 The cancellation policy is as follows:
- * 45 days or more before the tour date: 100% refund of the total booking amount.
- * 44-30 days before the tour date: 75% refund of the total booking amount.
